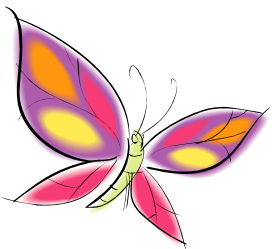
GET YOUR COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS*!!
